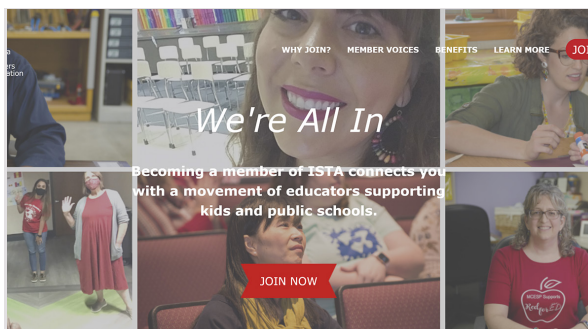

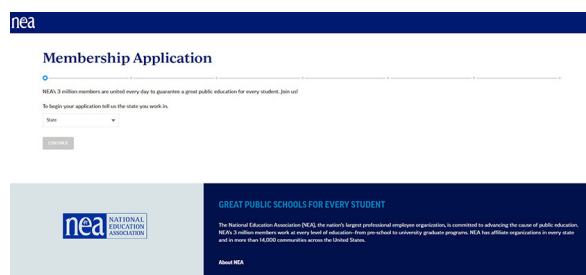

I-PACE
The Indiana Political Action Committee for Education (I-PACE) collects voluntary contributions from Association members and uses these contributions for political purposes. Including but not limited to, making contributions to and expenditures on behalf of friends of public education who are candidates for state office. Members wishing to opt out of contributions to I-PACE may do so by completing a PAC waiver which can be obtained from the ISTA website or the ISA MRC. Contributions or gifts to I-PACE are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. Only ISA citizens or permanent residents may contribute to I-PACE. If you are not eligible to contribute please contact ISTA before completing this form and sending your payment.

Review your membership information.

The SEA PAC, or the Indiana Political Action Committee for Education (I-PACE), is an important part of ISTA's advocacy on behalf of members. You're encouraged to contribute to support public education advocacy. However, if you do not wish to contribute to I-PACE, it is your legal right to opt out.

To opt out of contributions, complete a PAC waiver form and return it to the ISTA MRC. The form is available from your local, the ISTA MRC or at ista-in.org/resources. You can't opt-out-of the PAC contribution online.

NEA Fund
The National Education Association Fund for Children and Public Education (NEA Fund) collects voluntary contributions from Association members and uses these contributions for political purposes, including but not limited to, making contributions to and expenditures on behalf of House of Representatives who are candidates for federal office. Only U.S. citizens or lawful permanent residents may contribute to the NEA Fund. Contributions to the NEA Fund are voluntary making a contribution is neither a condition of employment nor membership in the Association, and members have the right to refuse to contribute without suffering any reprisal. Although the NEA Fund requests an annual contribution of \$10.00, this is only a suggestion. A member may contribute more or less than the suggested amount, or may contribute nothing at all, without it affecting his or her membership status, rights, or benefits in NEA or any of its affiliates. Only U.S. citizens or lawful permanent residents may contribute to the NEA Fund.

Contributions to the NEA Fund are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes.

Federal law requires political contributors to report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year.

IFIE
The House Political Action Committee for Education (IFIE) collects voluntary contributions from Association members and uses these contributions for political purposes, including but not limited to, making contributions to and expenditures on behalf of House of Representatives who are candidates for state office. Members wishing to opt out of contributions to IFIE may do so by completing a PAC waiver which can be obtained from the IEA website or the IEA HQ.

Contributions or gifts to IFIE are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. Only U.S. citizens or permanent residents may contribute to IFIE. If you are not eligible to contribute, please contact IEA before completing this form and completing your payment.
