Competitions and Contests:

State and National Contests- a little easier requirements and not as strenuous. Students are not compared to other competitors. Ribbons are awarded to Contest participants. They are score based-

Blue- 98-100

Red- 94-97

White- 90-93

State and National Competitions- these are performance based and an assessment of knowledge. Students are compared to other competitors.

The top 10 will be recognized.

The top 3 will receive awards.

Individual- 1 person

Individual/dual - is 1-2 students

Team- is 2-4 students and if they advance to nationals only 50% can be replaced. A team of 3 can only replace 1 person. You do not have to replace a team member. You must replace team members 7 days prior to nationals.

Use the Educators Rising web site, select student or teacher resources, then under national conference and competition resources select the review competition guidelines. Students and Advisors can select individual events and get the information. There is also an overview of all competitions and contests if students are curious of what is available. Please review the Guidelines as they will be what is used at State and Nationals for Judging.

National Conference Info:

Portland Oregon will host the 2026 Educators Rising Conference.

New this year:

- The conference will be held in a convention center with no attached hotels.
- You must have registered to attend the conference before hotel information will be available.
- The public train system will be used to get to and from the convention center. The public train tickets are included in your hotel stay
- Hotels will range in price with \$209 the highest price.
- You must stay in a conference hotel block to get discount on conference registration. This helps keep conference cost down as the room block discounts go towards fees at the conference center
- Indiana can block rooms so we can stay in one hotel- info to come later
