



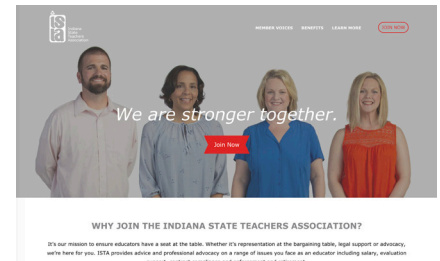

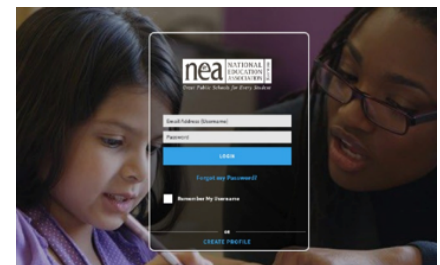

HOW DO I JOIN ONLINE?

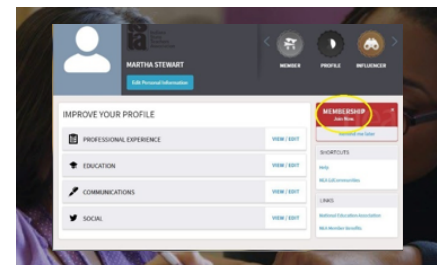
Step 1: Visit ista-in.org/JoinNow.



Step 2: Click on the Join Now button.



Step 3: Register or log in to edCommunities at MyNEA360.org.



Step 4: Navigate to MyNEA360 Profile. Click on the red Join Now button and follow the prompts to complete the online membership form. You will receive a confirmation email following your submission.

Q What if I don't see my work site listed online?

A Select a work site and complete the online membership form. Contact the ISTA Member Resource Center (MRC) to request the change. Please note in your communication to the ISTA MRC that your work site wasn't listed online.

Q What are NEA, SEA, SEA PAC and LEA?

A NEA is the National Education Association. SEA is the state education association – in our case the Indiana State Teachers Association (ISTA). SEA PAC is the state education association political action committee. LEA is your local education association.

Q How do I waive the PAC contribution?

A The Indiana Political Action Committee for Education (I-PACE) is an important part of ISTA's advocacy efforts on behalf of members. We encourage all members to contribute to the cause of advocating for public education. However, if you do not wish to contribute to I-PACE, it is your legal right to opt out. To opt out of contributions, you must complete a PAC waiver form and return it to the ISTA MRC. The form is available from your local, the ISTA MRC or on the ISTA website at ista-in.org/resources. You can't opt-out of the PAC contribution online.
